1) Up to 28 Children Lost Advocate in System

- Stuck in system 1-3 yrs more ightarrow
- 4x more likely to Age Out. > 11 9x, > $15 \sim 100\%$ •

2) If the child ages out

- Boys 7x and Girls 64x more likely to be arrested. ullet
 - **Conviction rates** 18x higher ullet
- Up to 8x more likely to be a victim of violent crime ullet
- 8x more likely to experience homelessness by age 21. •
- 60x more likely to be a victim of human trafficking by age 21 •
